

FINNISH OPEN JUNIOR MASTERS 2018-2019



New youth age groups U11, U13, U15, U17 and U20

Finnish Open Junior Masters 2018-2019 series has totally five (5) Masters Tournaments in each age category.

The Masters Tournaments (except U17/U20 Finnish Championships and the U17/U20 Masters Final) are open for all fencers from all FIE member federations.

Based on results in the tournaments **four (4) best fencers in U17 and U20 categories will be invited to fence in the Masters Finals 26.5.2019 in Porvoo**. To determine the Masters Final fencers tree (3) best points from Masters Tournaments are counted.

For youth categories U11-U13-U15 the 5th **Masters Final Tournament** is now open for all participants and gives double points. The best overall fencers will be awarded after this final tournament.

Age categories:

- U20 Juniors (born 1999 or later), separate competition for girls and boys
- U17 Cadets (born 2002 or later), separate competition for girls and boys
- U15 (born 2004 or later), separate competition for girls and boys
- U13 (born 2006 or later), mixed competition girls and boys
- U11 (born 2008 or later), mixed competition girls and boys

U15:	Fencing suit 350N, plastrong 800N, mask 350N
U20, U17:	Fencing suit 800N, plastrong 800N, mask 1600N
